SCRUTINIZER'S REPORT

I, S. SUDHARSAN, a practicing Chartered Accountant was having office at 7/8 & 9, G1, Jayarams Apts., Baroda 3rd Street, West Mambalam, Chennai – 600 033, appointed as Scrutinizer by the Board of Directors of **OPERATIONAL ENERGY GROUP INDIA LIMITED** (“the Company”) for the purpose of scrutinizing the e-voting process (remote e-voting) in a fair and transparent manner pursuant to Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the 2013 Act) read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (and amendment Rules, 2015) in respect of resolution(s) proposed at 26th Annual General Meeting held on Wednesday, 17th September, 2020 at the Registered Office of the company A, 5th Floor, Gokul Arcade, No. 2&2A Sardar Patel Road, Adyar, Chennai – 600 020 in the state of Tamil Nadu, India.

I submit my report as under:

1. The Management of the company is responsible to ensure the compliance of the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and Rules relating to e-voting for the resolutions proposed in the Notice of the Company. My responsibility as a Scrutinizer is restricted to make a Scrutinizer’s Report for the votes cast in “favour” or “against” the resolution stated above, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system provided by Central Securities Depository Limited (CDSL), authorised under the Rules and engaged by the Company to provide e-voting facilities for voting through electronic means in respect of the resolutions considered at the Twenty-Sixth Annual General Meeting of the shareholders of the Company.
2. The e-voting period remained open from 14th September, 2020 at 9.00 A.M. (IST) and ended at 5.00 P.M. on 16th September, 2020.
3. The member holding shares on the “Cut-Off” date i.e., 09th September, 2020 were entitled to vote on the resolutions (Item No. 1 & 2) as set out in the notice of the 26th Annual General Meeting of the Company.
4. After the time fixed for closing of e-voting, e-voting facility was made available during the AGM for the members attending the meeting through the online facility and who did not exercise their vote when the e-voting process was open, to cast their vote. The e-voting

records were reconciled with the records maintained by the Company/ Registrar and Transfer Agents and the authorizations with the Company.

5. The votes for remote e-voting process were unblocked on 17th September, 2020 in the presence of two witnesses who are not in the employment of the Company. Thereafter, the details containing, inter alia list of equity shareholders, who voted “for” and “against” were downloaded from the e-voting website of CDSL.
